Credit Recommendation Guide (CRG)

The credits described below can be awarded provided they do not duplicate any of the following:

- Program Coursework
- Transfer Credit
- Assessed Credit
- National Testing Program Credit

Recommended Semester Credit Conversion - The standard formula for determining credit value is as follows:

15.0 hours of classroom learning is equivalent to 1.0 semester credit

30.0 hours of Lab, Clinical or Self-Paced hours is equivalent to 1.0 semester credit

Note: Only the college level content of a course is converted to credit. The non-academic portion is not converted to credit.

Combinable: Courses may only be combined with courses of similar content. Combined courses of differing General Education areas will not be awarded a General Education discipline. Classroom learning that is less than 15 clock hours may be combined with similar course work in 7.5 hour increments which is equivalent to 0.5 credit hours. Lab, Clinical or Self-Paced course hours less than 30 clock hours may be combined with similar course work in increments of 15 hours which is equivalent to 0.5 credit hours.

University of Phoenix Equivalency: General Education or Elective category to which credit can be applied.

Non-Academic: Lack of college level theory and/or principle necessary for credit recognition.
